LOCATION OF PROGRAMME

The programme is based at the Craiglockhart campus of Napier University which is located some 20 minutes from Edinburgh city centre by public transport. The location is stunning, set on a hill overlooking the city of Edinburgh, with modern classrooms and beautiful lawns.

THE PROGRAMME

The young learner summer school offers a fun & stimulating programme where the students discover the beautiful city of Edinburgh, learn about Scottish history and culture through English learning activities, explore museums, galleries, parks and gardens and visit Castles and historic sites. There are various half day and full day trips to locations outside Edinburgh which may include places such as Glasgow, Stirling and St Andrews.

Living with a host family also allows students to experience true Scottish hospitality whilst continually practicing and improving their English.

ENGLISH CLASSES

The programme includes 15 hours per week of English language tuition (3 hours each morning) comprising topic based General English classes and cultural lessons using task based learning methodology. The emphasis is on speaking and listening.

CREATIVE PROJECT WORK

A unique feature of the programme is 5 hours per week of supervised project work, which enables the students to further develop and practise their English skills. These sessions give students the opportunity of working together creatively to apply English through activities such as video production, Scottish dance/drama and photo story competitions

2015 PROGRAMME DATES

The programme can be booked for between 2 and 6 weeks and is available to groups and individuals. The dates offered in 2015 are from Sunday 28th June to Saturday 8th August.
