LOCATION OF PROGRAMME

The Young Learner Summer Programme is based at the modern and scenic campus of Stirling University. The historic city of Stirling is ideally situated close to the Highlands of Scotland and is less than 1 hour travelling time from the major cities of Glasgow and Edinburgh.

For students interested in future study in the UK, this location provides them with an ideal opportunity to experience living on a university campus.

THE PROGRAMME

ENGLISH CLASSES

A unique feature of the programme is 5 hours per week of supervised project work, which enables the students to further develop and practise their English skills. These fun sessions give students the opportunity of working together creatively to apply English through activities such as video production, Scottish dance/drama and photo story competitions.
